

100 percent matric pass rate at UJ Metropolitan Academy yet again! Class of 2015

The MMI Foundation extends its congratulations to the Matric class of 2015 at Johannesburg's UJ Metropolitan Academy (ex Raucall), who have again achieved a 100% pass rate; consistent with the past 21 years. The Academy is a beneficiary of Metropolitan through the MMI Foundation.

95.8% of the 2015 matrics at UJ Metropolitan secured bachelor passes and 3.2% obtained diploma endorsement. This means that all the school's matrics qualify to continue their studies at tertiary level. The class of 2015 also achieved a total of 120 distinctions. One learner attained eight distinctions, including Advanced Programme Maths, for which she obtained 95%. Three other learners achieved six distinctions each and another four received five distinctions each.

The learners are assisted to achieve a good high school foundation in preparation for tertiary education. Metropolitan joined hands with UJ Metropolitan Academy (ex Raucall) in 1994 and from 2011 the project was supported by the MMI Foundation.
